Whole roasted Babi Guling and a repertoire of seafood plates complement Town Restaurant's daily dinner buffet spread



SINGAPORE, 17 March 2017 – Hot off the heels from receiving a five-star Forbes rating for The Villas at AYANA Resort, the culinary team from AYANA will bring their bar none Balinese cuisine to Town Restaurant, The Fullerton Hotel Singapore from 4 to 14 April 2017. Enjoy signatures like crackling *Babi Guling*, spicy *Bebek Betutu* and king prawn *Udang Kalas* by the Singapore River waterfront. Led by guest chef I Made Arie Wahyudi, a renaissance man who enjoys playing traditional Balinese music as much as he loves cooking, the culinary team will present an extensive dinner buffet presented at twelve savoury and sweet stations.

High notes of the buffet include a whole roasted Suckling Pig, seared belly-down to a salty crisp on the skin, and street food classics like *Nasi Jenggo* – rich coconut-turmeric rice lavishly elevated AYANA-style by chunky braised beef stewed in coconut, lemongrass and lime leaves. Plump skewers of chicken, pork and *cumi* (squid) satay are seasoned in an



exotic spice blend and served plain, fresh-off-the-grill with no sauce so the rich char-grilled flavours speak for themselves.

Similar to local fare, Balinese cuisine stems from Indian and Chinese roots. Drawing parallels to the suite of Singapore cuisine available at Town, Chef Arie plays up this connection through a repertoire of seafood plates. King prawn *Udang Kalas* is punctuated by a luscious yellow coconut curry; and Chinese-style steamed lobster is draped in accents of chilli, shallots and ginger flowers and artfully prepared with mastery in timing.

Sweet notes from homemade Indonesian desserts balance the spice on your palate. From the padi fields, enjoy warm bowls of *Bubur Injin* black rice pudding, stirred labouriously till it reaches a sticky consistency, and divine when paired with a scoop of coconut ice-cream. Alternatively, unwrap steaming *Jongkong Tabu* pumpkin cake individually sealed in aromatic banana leaves; or relish *Kolak Ubi*, sweet potato and sago slow-stewed till soft in coconut cream palm sugar to complete an authentic, unpretentious Balinese dining experience.

By dining with us, travel and food enthusiasts also stand to win a two-night stay with breakfast for two in an Ocean View Suite at RIMBA Jimbaran BALI by AYANA in Town Restaurant's lucky draw.

The Fullerton Hotel's "Authentic Balinese Flavours" co-sponsored by AYANA Resort and Spa, and Garuda Indonesia takes place from 4 to 14 April 2017, 6.30 p.m. to 10.30 p.m. The dinner buffet also includes a local spread with favourites such as Laksa (rice vermicelli in spicy coconut gravy), as well as Town Restaurant's famous Hainanese Chicken Rice, which has earned its reputation as one of the best chicken rice in "Town".
