The Clifford Pier

This was the heart of yesteryear's bustling hawker culture and the landing point of Singapore's forefathers as they descended from the original Clifford Pier. **The Singapore Heritage Afternoon Tea** serves to encapsulate this era, with eight sweet and eight savoury dishes that pay tribute to our multi-cultural influences. Discover familiar flavours in the Chilli Bak Kwa Jam on Savoury Egg Tart, where the sweet-salty conserve is crafted from charcoal-grilled pork marinated in chilli. The long-lost skill of Roti Jala is revived with a soft lacy pancake that envelopes piquant Nonya-style Chicken Curry.



Sweets are similarly rooted in local nuances. Bandung – a refreshing favourite of rose syrup and evaporated milk – is reinterpreted into pretty pink Macarons, while buttery scones are dolloped with Homemade Kaya or a deliciously tart Passion Fruit and Mango Jam. *\$45 per person. Items are refillable and inclusive of a choice of beverage.*
Monday to Friday: 3.30 p.m to 5.30 p.m. Saturday, Sunday and Public Holidays: 3 p.m. to 5 p.m.

Suggested activitea: Continue the heritage immersion at the newly revamped The Fullerton Heritage Gallery (The Fullerton Hotel Singapore Lobby Level). The comprehensive museum experience features a recreation of the first floor when it served as a General Post Office, insights into the pioneers that worked here (including Goh Chok Tong and S.R. Nathan), and activities specially tailored for children.

The Landing Point

The destination of choice for high-powered executives and the socialite set alike, The Landing Point elevates **Afternoon Tea** to a posh affair. Delight in Boston Lobster nestled in Crispy Cornets, Duck Rillettes in Sesame Buns, and Smoked Salmon Millefeuille with Caviar while taking in the splendid waterfront view. As staples are constantly refilled by staff toting silver trays, guests can also nibble on French-inspired pastries like deeply caramelised Caneles and fluffy Madeleines from their personal sets. *\$45 per person. Inclusive of free-flow coffee and tea. Monday to Friday: 3.00 p.m. to 5.30 p.m. Saturday, Sunday and Public Holidays: 12.30 p.m. to 3.00 p.m. (first seating), 3.30 p.m. to 6.00 p.m. (second seating).*

An Exquisite Evening Tea steers from convention by extending the late-afternoon ritual into the hours of 6.30 p.m. to 10.30 p.m. Light bites – such as Smoked Salmon Avruga Caviar Crouton, Breaded Calamari in Cocktail Sauce, and Blood Orange and Arriba Cinnamon Chocolate Mousse – serve as the ideal hunger-staver when a full dinner is not what you're after. Come for the delectable fare and stay for the captivating ambience of bespoke marble mosaics and jewelled hues. *\$45 per person. Inclusive of free-flow coffee, tea, soft drinks and juices.*

Suggested activitea: Just a few short steps away from The Fullerton Bay Hotel is the Merlion Park, where you can hop on a restored bumboat for a river cruise or simply take in the sweeping Marina Bay view at sundown (cont'd).

The Courtyard

While away a leisurely afternoon in the sunlit atrium lobby over a **Traditional English Afternoon Tea**. Traditionalists will love classics like Cucumber with Salmon Roe, and Mini Bagels with Prosciutto Ham and Cheddar Cheese, while those who appreciate some pizzazz will be inclined to give Otak Otak Sandwiches with Quail's Egg and Curried Egg Sandwiches a whirl. Save room for the sweet tiers, which feature up to nine selections of eclairs, tarts, macarons, financiers and cakes. Reach for a bubbly flute of Veuve Clicquot Ponsardin Reims or a soothing cup of TWG tea to accompany the delicate treats. *\$43 per person. Inclusive of free-flow coffee and tea. Monday to Friday: 3.00 p.m. to 5.00 p.m. Saturday, Sunday and Public Holidays: 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. (first seating), 4.30 p.m. to 6.00 p.m. (second seating)*

Get inducted into Singapore's unique coffee culture with **Heritage Coffee at The Courtyard**. Sip on robust local coffee made from beans wok-roasted with sugar and margarine and ask for condensed or evaporated milk (not regular!) on the side. Complement the aromatic cuppa with comforting kaya (coconut jam) toast and a slice of kueh lapis. The hotel's signature cake is meticulously baked layer by layer and features hints of buttery cinnamon. *\$18 per set. Daily: 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.*

Suggested activitea: Let our resident guides take you back in time to when this historical building first served as a colonial outpost. The Fullerton Monument Tour is where tourists and heritage buffs

Town

There's no shortage of weekend tea buffets but you'd be hard-pressed to find one that places you right along the waterfront. The **Singapore High Tea Buffet** unfolds at Town which faces the Singapore River and offers a slew of local favourites. Watch chefs at the live stations prepare traditional popiah (fresh spring rolls) and kueh pie tee, then discover the fluffy textures of soft local breads with their fillings of red bean paste, chicken floss and creamy custard. Customise nasi lemak (coconut rice) just the way you like it with crispy prawn paste chicken wings, salted roast peanuts and otak otak (spicy fish paste) wrapped in fragrant banana leaves while still leaving room for claypot dishes, and laksa, mee siam and mee rubus at the live noodle stations. *\$36 per person. Inclusive of free-flow coffee and tea. Every Saturday and public holidays: 12.00 p.m. to 3.00 p.m.*

Suggested activitea: The allure of the placid bay should convince you to embark on A Maritime Journey Tour. It tells a different but no less important story of Singapore's historic waterfront that began as a fledgling trading post before it flourished into the port city it is today. Gluten-free and vegetarian tea sets

At The Courtyard and The Landing Point, every care has been taken to cater to guests with special dietary needs. The **Vegetarian** selections are every bit as elegant, comprising grilled Mediterranean vegetables on a buttery brioche roll, Brie cheese topped with plum jelly, and petite cups fashioned from cucumber that cradle sun-dried tomato and feta cheese. More impressively, the culinary team has also devised a **Gluten-Free** set, featuring *Tiger Prawn with Avruga Caviar* and *Smoked Duck Mango Salsa with Brown Bread*. On the dessert front, there's plenty to satiate the sweet tooth with *Gluten-free Chocolate Cake* and *Chocolate Caramel "Ovalis"*. *\$43 per person at The Courtyard, \$45 per person at The Landing Point. 24-hour advanced orders are highly recommended.*
