Celebrate the Mid-Autumn Festival with The Fullerton Hotel Sydney as they bring authentic Southeast Asian flavours to Sydney with their inaugural mooncake collection. **The Fullerton Hotel Sydney's Mooncake Collection** features a quartet of exquisite flavours, elegantly presented in either a turquoise or ruby-red signature box; the perfect gift for family and loved ones.

Media Release - SYDNEY, 25 August 2021: The Mid-Autumn Festival is a time-honoured Chinese tradition centred around family and celebrating the Harvest Moon. A quintessential Mid-Autumn treat meant to be shared, mooncakes are traditional round pastries made from wheat flour and filled with a sweet or savoury filling.

Circular in shape, mooncakes hold rich cultural significance; they signify the full moon, which in turn symbolises completeness – being whole and full – and the reunion of family. They are traditionally cut into pieces that equal the number of members in a family, with each family member eating one piece each, accompanied with hot tea.

The Fullerton Hotel Sydney's inaugural Mooncake Collection is inspired by its Singaporean roots and a nod to the Lion City's local hawker scene. The Mooncake Collection showcases four exquisite flavours starring classic and nostalgic ingredients that transcend generations, in combinations that are unique and experimental. Two flavours are from the **Jade Signatures Mooncake Collection 2021** from the award-winning Jade restaurant at **The Fullerton Hotel Singapore**, while the other two flavours are from **The Clifford Pier Mooncake Tingkat** from **The Fullerton Bay Hotel Singapore**.

The Hotel's Mooncake Collection features bespoke embossing with three Chinese characters imprinted on each pastry. The Chinese characters constitute the official Chinese name of the Fullerton brand and, when pronounced phonetically, sound similar to the name 'Fullerton'. Individually, these characters translate to the words 'abundance', 'elegance' and 'sincerity' respectively.

The elegant flavour medley gives prominence to wholesome, nutty and fruity elements for a divine journey that is familiar yet surprising, delightful and inspiring; the perfect vessel for creating unforgettable Fullerton memories.



Mixed Nuts with Satay Sauce

The classic mixed nuts mooncake is given a new lease on life as it comes laced with a daring and unique, yet delicious ingredient – satay sauce, made from ground roasted nuts. Typically enjoyed with satay – a well-loved grilled meat skewer dish commonly found in Singapore and other parts of Southeast Asia – the satay sauce brings a rich complexity and will appeal to those with a penchant for a melange of sweet, savoury and mildly spicy flavours.

Reduced Sugar White Lotus Seed Paste

This traditional mooncake flavour is filled with the finest lotus seed paste for a smooth and authentic result that effortlessly elevates the Mid-Autumn Festival experience. With the Hotel's guests' health and wellbeing in mind, this perennial classic features a luxurious reduced sugar recipe, which appeals to those seeking a healthier option.

Oolong Tea with Dried Cranberries

Starring two key ingredients that are well-known for their antioxidant properties, this special creation signifies wishes of wellbeing and health to recipients. The distinctive complexity of Oolong Tea, with its toasty, tannic undertones and robust fragrance, is infused into the mooncake's lotus paste filling, which is in turn studded with dainty pieces of tangy dried cranberries for a bright contrast. The result is a harmonic symphony of flavours and aromas.

Assam Lotus with Mango

An exemplification of classic artistry, the baked Assam Lotus with Mango Mooncake is bound to impress even the most discerning of connoisseurs. With the tangy and sharp flavours of assam, or tamarind, interlaced with the tropical sweetness of mango and smooth lotus paste, the interplay of rich and robust flavours is seamless.

The Fullerton Hotel Sydney's four mooncake flavours are presented in a luxurious red or turquoise signature box, adorned with graceful imagery of blossoms and majestic peacocks that exude the Fullerton brand's classic allure.
