## SPARKLING

Glass Bottle

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NV	Louis Perdrier Brut	Cote d'Or, France	10	50
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*This French sparkling wine is a blend of white grapes including Ugni blanc, Colombard, Chenin, Folle Blanche, and Menu Pineau. After the second fermentation, they undergo an extended ageing on the lees in vats in order to produce a sparkling wine with good balance and longevity.*

NV	Dal Zotto Pucino Prosecco	King Valley, Victoria	11	59
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*This prosecco offers a lifted bouquet with hints of fresh cut pear, citrus blossom and lemon that leap out of the glass. The palate is soft, appealing, approachable and basically a whole lot of fun, with gentle bubbles and alcohol combining seamlessly.*

## WHITE

Glass Bottle

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2018	Tai Nui Sauvignon Blanc	Marlborough, New Zealand	10	49
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*The fruit was carefully picked, machine harvested and then cool fermented in stainless steel tanks using yeast strains. This helps retain the freshness, bright fragrances and sweet fruit flavours of the wine. The rich and intense palate structure is full of juicy flavours of grapefruit, white stonefruit and lemongrass leading to a lengthy and mouthwatering finale.*

2018	Willow Bridge Estate Chardonnay	Geographe, Western Australia	11	54
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*70% of the wine was naturally fermented in pre-loved French oak barriques to build complexity through barrel fermentation, whilst the balance was fermented in tank, retaining freshness and bright fruit aromatics. It highlights the classic white-fleshed stonefruit and almond blossom characters of the variety, combined with the texture, complexity and depth of flavour achieved from the better vineyard sites of the southwest.*

## RED

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2015	Heartland 'Spice Trader' Shiraz	Langhorne Creek, South Australia	12	60
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*The cool climate of Langhorne Creek typifies Australia at its finest. Packed with regional mint, rich black plum and berry compote fruit, red liquorice and fine, textural tannins. This wine has impressive fruit impact and is a great example of South Australian Shiraz.*

2019	Airlie Bank Pinot Noir	Yarra Valley, Victoria	12	60
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*Made with Cru Beaujolais as an inspiration. The grapes were picked in the red fruit spectrum, minimally fined and filtered. Notes of Campari, red liquorice and boysenberry. On the palate – bright, fresh and bursting with juvenile charm.*

2017	S.C. Pannell 'Dead End' Tempranillo	McLaren Vale, South Australia	13	65
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*Winemaker Steve Pannell was awarded the 2015 Gourmet Traveller winemaker of the year award. This wine has light to medium body, good tannins and notes of ripe banana, plum, cola and sarsaparilla.*

## ROSÉ

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2018	Debussy Reverie Rosé	Pays d'Oc, France	11	54
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*Salmon pink in the glass with an elegant red fruit nose and aromas of raspberry. Well balanced with a concentrated impression and a fruity finish. The terroir of warmer and maritime location shows in this wines full bodied and rich texture and flavours.*

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2019	Yeringa Ridge Sauvignon Blanc		8	39
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*A pale straw coloured wine showing aromas of cut grass, apple, lime, pineapple and passion fruit with a subtle hint of peach. The palate shows passionfruit, pineapple, green apple with a finish reminiscent of sweet grass.*

2018	Yeringa Ridge Shiraz		8	39
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*Has a deep rich purple colour showing intense fruit on both bouquet and palate. Firm tannins are pleasantly balanced with subtle hints of spice and plum. Works well with pasta, red meat, game and cheese.*

<b>CARLTON DRAUGHT</b> 4.6% Alc/Vol	6.5	12
<i>This beer dates back to 1864. This was when the same Clydesdales that grace the taps, glasses and packs today, delivered the first batch of Carlton to pubs in the local area.</i>		
<b>FURPHY REFRESHING ALE</b> 4.4% Alc/Vol	6.5	12
<i>Furphy is a new, refreshing ale that is Geelong born and brewed from 100% Victorian ingredients. The first sip is clean and crisp, with a subtle balance of fruit and malt to keep it interesting. The finish is smooth and pleasantly refreshing.</i>		
<b>BONAMY'S APPLE CIDER</b> 4.0% Alc/Vol	6.5	12
<i>Tasmanian Cider Co. started making quality ciders over 100 years ago. Using a blend incorporating local and seasonal fruit, the use of whole pressed Tasmanian Apples and white wine yeast results in a mild, dry bite on the palate which rounds out the fullness and provides a beautiful balanced cider. Gluten free.</i>		
<b>JAMES SQUIRE '150 LASHES' PALE ALE</b> 4.2% Alc/Vol	6.5	12
<i>Launched in 2011, this thirst-quenching Australian pale ale has proved a hit with customers around the country. Malted wheat adds refreshing character, while the fruity infusion makes for an enticing aroma.</i>		
<b>4 PINES INDIAN SUMMER ALE</b> 4.2% Alc/Vol	6.5	12
<i>Crisp &amp; light in bitterness with aromas of passionfruit &amp; honeydew, light body, but not at the expense of hop character. To be enjoyed now and long after the sun's gone down.</i>		
<b>COBURG LAGER</b> 4.6% Alc/Vol	7	13
<i>A dry but slightly fruity lager with a clean biscuit malt flavour, subtle citrus fruit notes and a gentle spicy hop character derived from the Czech-grown Saaz hops. Really it's just a simple tasty number you can sit on all night.</i>		
<b>GUINNESS</b> 4.2% Alc/Vol	7	13
<i>Developed in 1959, this beer was a fitting way to mark 200 years of ground-breaking brewing. With a skilful pairing of nitrogen gas and carbon dioxide, the smooth, velvety texture was born. Distinguished by its surge upon pouring, its complexity and its bold combination of flavours.</i>		
<b>GOOSE ISLAND IPA</b> 5.9% Alc/Vol	7	13
<i>This India Pale Ale recalls a time when ales shipped from England to India were highly hopped to preserve their distinct taste during the long journey. The result is a hop lover's dream with a fruity aroma, set off by a dry malt middle, and long hop finish. This beer won gold at the World Beer Cup Awards and a number of medals at the Great American Beer Festival.</i>		
<b>PANHEAD 'QUICKCHANGE' XPA PALE ALE</b> 4.6% Alc/Vol	7	13
<i>Panhead is New Zealand's very own craft brewing monster truck rally, putting the frighteners on anyone who thinks beer should mind its own business and cower behind the wine rack.</i>		
<i>XPA means Extra Pale, a product of Quickchange's lighter malt base. That delicate colour though is undercut by a glorious hit of alpha oils from Mosaic, Galaxy and Citra hops, with a few luscious notes of mango, guava, lychee and pineapple.</i>		
<b>HEINEKEN</b> 5.0% Alc/Vol	7	13
<i>This internationally recognised European pale lager was first brewed by Gerard Adriaan Heineken in 1873 at his Amsterdam brewery. It is brewed only with purified water, malted barley, hops and importantly Heineken A-yeast, a proprietary yeast strain developed by H. Elion in 1886.</i>

COSMOPOLITAN 18

*Vodka and Cointreau combined with lime and cranberry juice.*

DAIQUIRI 18

*White rum, fresh lime juice and sugar syrup shaken over ice and strained into a martini glass.*

ESPRESSO MARTINI 21

*Whilst classically requiring coffee, Kahlua and vodka, our recipe adds a dash of Crème de Cacao and Frangelico.*

FRENCH MARTINI 18

*Vodka, pineapple juice and Crème de Cassis shaken over ice.*

*\* Upgrade to Grey Goose Vodka for \$23*

GIMLET 18

*Gin, lime juice and simple syrup shaken and strained and garnished with a lime wheel.*

*\* Upgrade to Hendricks or Four Pillars Gin - \$23*

JAPANESE SLIPPER 18

*Midori and Cointreau liquors, brought together with a squeeze of fresh lemon juice.*

LONG ISLAND ICED TEA 18

*An impressive line-up of Bombay Gin, Bacardi Rum, Jose Cuervo Tequila, Eristoff Vodka and Cointreau, veiled by a small amount of lemon juice and Coca Cola.*

MANHATTAN 18

*Rye Whiskey and sweet vermouth stirred with Angostura Bitters is all it takes... Oh, and a cherry on top of course.*

MARGARITA 18

*Jose Cuervo Tequila and Cointreau mixed with lime juice and served in a salt-rimmed glass.*

NEGRONI 19

*Equal parts Campari, gin and sweet vermouth stirred over ice.*

*\* Upgrade to Hendricks or Four Pillars Gin for \$24*

OLD FASHIONED 18

*A sugar cube is muddled beneath an orange slice, seasoned with bitters and topped with Rye whiskey.*

SIDECAR 18

*Brandy, Cointreau, & lemon juice is shaken and presented in a sugar-rimmed glass.*
