- 10 Whispering Angel, Chateau D'Esclans, Côtes du Provence, France** **\$98**
Delicate, with a mineral undertone flanking the white cherry, peach and raspberry notes, interwoven with spice and herb details. Lingering finish. Grenache, Vermentino, Syrah, Cinsault and Tibouren
- 14 AIX, Coteaux D'Aix-en-Provence, France** **\$96**
A lovely pale, salmon pink color with beautiful, shiny reflections. The nose is quite delicate, fruit-forward, clean and complex, with notes of fresh red fruits, peach and some subtle floral hints
- 15 M de Minuty, Côtes de Provence, France** **\$92**
Light and bright. Very intense of greedy aromas or orange peels and red currant. Smooth with a nice acidulous freshness

WHITE WINES

PINOT GRIGIO

- 16 Santa Margherita, Alto Adige, Italy** **\$92**
Bright golden hue with a refreshing nose that integrates classic pear and apple fragrances with elegant hints of floral and citrus. The palate, dry on entry, reveals substantial structure and lingering, refreshing savouriness.
- 21 Cavit, Tre Venezie, Italy** **\$72**
Bright straw gold, delicate and pleasing with floral and citrus scents; dry, light and crisp
- 19 La Crema Pinot Gris, Monterey, California** **\$98**
Bright and balanced, this wine opens with aromas of fresh white peach, Meyer lemon and subtle floral hints. The lush palate is layered with flavors of ripe pear, baking spice and exotic tropical notes. Mineral undertones are evident in the lengthy finish
- 43 Pasqua, Trentino-Alto Adige, Italy** **\$65**
Pleasant, fruity wine with notes of pear, apricot, and floral hints; fresh, harmonious, and well balanced

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SAUVIGNON BLANC

- 31 Maipo Reserva, Valle de Casa Blanca, Chile **\$68**
Fruity, herbaceous, and peaches aroma; refreshingly balanced semi dry palate
- 28 Nobile, Marlborough, New Zealand **\$100**
Pale yellow in color. Bright, lifted tropical fruit and herbs with notes of pineapple, elderflower, cantaloupe and citrus. On the palate a lively acidity perfectly balances the underlying fruit sweetness. Fresh and crisp on the finish
- 30 Cloudy Bay, Marlborough, New Zealand **\$150**
Fresh and vibrant on the nose, with aromatics of bright citrus, kaffir lime, orchard blossoms and passion fruit. Juicy stone fruit and subtle tropical characters underpinned by a fine minerality and meyer lemon acidity on the palate
- 42 Simi, Sonoma County, California **\$99**
Fruit-forward flavors and aromas of stone fruit, apricot, orange blossom, grapefruit, lemon oil, a touch of herbaceousness and a hint of floral character meld beautifully with a vibrant acidity.
- 47 Mud House, Marlborough, New Zealand **\$96**
Pale straw yellow in color. Lifted aromatic nose of snow pea, citrus and passionfruit. It has a palate of fresh greens and ripe tropical flavors. The crisp grapefruit acidity to a long mouth-watering finish.
- 45 Kim Crawford, Marlborough, New Zealand **\$120**
A bouquet of citrus and tropical fruits backed by characteristic herbaceous notes. An exuberant wine brimming with flavors of pineapple and stone fruit with a hint of herbaceousness on the palate. The finish is fresh and zesty.
- 41 Bonterra, North Coast, California (made with organic grapes) **\$95**
An unmistakable aroma of grapefruit, woven over an exotic thread of kumquat, cherimoya, mango and passionfruit. The expressive nose gives way to a crisp and lively palate, culminating in a mouthwatering finish.

CHARDONNAY

- 18 Round Hill, Rutherford Vineyards, California **\$70**
Bright gold in color with aromas of Meyer lemon, pear and honeysuckle, with hints of vanilla and cinnamon
- 17 Flowers, Sonoma Coast, Sonoma County, California **\$205**
Bright citrus notes, white flower, nuances of dried apricot and hints of flint. Palate is energetic with acidity and tension balanced with flavors of orchard fruit and almond, finishing long and bright.
- 34 Cakebread Cellars, Napa Valley, California **\$220**
Nose of white fruits, subtle vanilla with toasty nuances of pear; flavors of pineapple and melon
- 46 Joseph Carr, Josh Cellars, California **\$85**
The nose exudes aromas of tropical fruits and citrus married with subtle oak notes. The palate is bright and fresh, with lingering flavors of juicy yellow peaches, lemon oil and crème brûlée. The wine shows great, soft texture and finishes long.
- 37 Stonestreet, Estate Vineyards, Healdsburg, California **\$110**
Notes of caramel apple and pineapple upside down cake with subtle salinity. The rich and round palate is highlighted by fresh tropical fruits, salted caramel, and a clean inviting finish.
- 20 Sonoma Cutrer, "The Cutrer", Russian River Valley, Sonoma County, California **\$150**
A rich, complex wine. Integrated oak notes of caramel, roasted nuts, honey, fresh Bosc pear, ripe peach, nectarine, honeydew, melon accented with nougat, brown sugar, baking spice and red apple.
A creamy mid-palate mouthfeel with bright acidity and a long, rich finish.

Bright, fresh and vivacious on the palate, the tropical fruit flavors are lifted by a streak of Atlantic-coast salinity.
- 38 Caymus Conundrum, White Blend Vineyards, Napa Valley **\$110**
Layers of peach, apricot nectar, green melon, and pear with notes of citrus zest and vanilla
- 36 Banrock Station, Moscato, Riverland, South Australia **\$59**
Fresh summer fruits and grape flavors, with a sweet Muscaty character.
A gentle spritz give the palate a lively, rich finish.
- 33 Dr. Loosen Bros, Riesling, Germany **\$82**
A bright, vibrant, fruit-driven wine, with a juicy mid-palate and a crisp dry finish

Dry, elegant, aromatic. Aromas of broom plant, jasmine, acacia, boxtree
- 24 Pascal Jolivet "Sancerre", Route de Chavignol, Sancerre, France **\$150**
Fresh, clean and youthful with delicate nuances of lime, grapefruit, green apple and kiwi. On the palate it has a soft entry leading to a polished supple texture with gentle, well integrated acidity; medium bodied with lingering citrus-apple aromatic notes.
- 54 Jean-Louis Quinson "La Joue du Roy" Pouilly Fuissé, Burgundy, France **\$100**
Complex, with delicate lemon rind and golden delicious apple aromas that combine with rich toasted almond notes on the palate.

- 23 Louis Latour, Puligny Montrachet, Burgundy, France **\$390**
Bright golden color. The nose is intense with notes of vanilla and fresh almonds. The full-bodied and rounded mouth unveils delicious aromas of yellow peach and almond paste. Lovely mineral finish.
- 27 Louis Latour, Chablis, Burgundy, France **\$130**
Beautiful pale yellow color with green lights, offering floral notes with subtle hints of almond paste. Nice final tension.
- 32 Louis Latour, Saint Véran, Maconnais, France **\$95**
Floral aromas with subtle honeysuckle, tasting offers muscat-like hints

RED BURGUNDY

- 65 Louis Latour, Gevrey-Chambertin, Burgundy, France **\$315**
Raspberry, boysenberry, soft texture and lasting finish; full, tannic structure
- 71 Louis Latour, Nuits-Saint-Georges, Côte de Nuits, France **\$295**
Bright and intense ruby red color. Fruity and lightly aniseed on the nose with gourmet aromas of cherry and liquorice as well as on the palate. The mouth is round and fresh with a nice tannic finish

PINOT NOIR

- 61 Cavit, Lombardy, Italy \$78
A youthful, vibrant purple; delicate and alluring aromas of black cherry; silky smooth with well-defined fruit redolent of red berries with cherry notes
- 62 Hahn Estate, Monterey County, Soledad, California \$98
Aromas of red and dark cherry, dried raspberry and rhubarb pie are joined by subtle touches of spice and toasty oak. The palate is full-bodied with silky tannins, soft round mouthfeel, excellent acid balance, and notes of earthiness on a long lingering finish.
- 59 Flowers, Sonoma Coast, Sonoma County, California \$225
Red currents, earthy forest floor, bergamot and sea breeze. A balanced wine with persistent mid palate that is laced with acidity and tart cherry, finishing light and lifted with a twist of blood orange.
- 63 Duckhorn Wine Co., Migration Vineyards, Anderson Valley, California \$175
Lovely texture and tension and generous fruit. On the palate, alluring layers of blackberry, raspberry and cranberry mingle with hints of forest floor and subtle toasty oak, carrying the wine to a rich and polished finish.
- 60 Firesteed, Willamette Valley, Oregon \$118
Aromas of fresh, wild blueberries, cinnamon and orange zest; complex finish
- 80 ZD Wines, Carneros, California \$198
Rich ruby color. Classic aromas of briary black cherry with raspberry and strawberry. Very luscious and silky palate with bright fruit and cedar notes. Soft acidity and tannins
- 68 Wild Ridge, Annapolis, California \$140
Aromas of fresh blackberry, ripe red cherries and oolong tea complimented by flavors of pomegranate, raspberry and orange zest. Firm tannins
- 49 Twomey, Russian River Valley, California \$220
Black plum, cassis and sweet berry, finishing with great depth, balance and focus.
- 58 Belle Glos, Clark & Telephone, Wagner Family Winery, Santa Maria Valley, California \$260
Aromas and flavours of ripe raspberries and red currant dominated by a crunch spiciness.

SHIRAZ/SYRAH

- 39 Stags Leap, Petite Syrah, Stags' Leap Winery, Napa Valley, California **\$220**
Generous blackberry & peppery plum flavours with cherry and cassis notes. Delicate anise seed, clove and cedar spice notes from the oak ageing.
- 69 Hardy's Nottage Hill Cabernet-Shiraz, South Eastern, Australia **\$68**
Rich plum, cassis and mulberry fruit flavors complemented by subtle savory oak
- 70 Bogle Petite Sirah, California **\$96**
Jammy notes with black fruit berries, currants and spice; toasty oak, cocoa and leather
- 79 Montes Folly Syrah, Colchagua Valley, Chile **\$205**
Very elegant on the nose offering aromas of blueberries and black currants; light notes of chocolate and subtle toast. Robust and well balanced on the palate with smooth tannins, long pleasing finish

ZINFANDEL

- 74 Ravenswood, Lodi, California **\$82**
Explodes with blueberries, black plums, vanilla, and cocoa. Lush, mouth filling, with incredibly silky tannins.
- 77 Murphy Goode, "Liar's Dice", Sonoma, California **\$86**
Deep aromas and luscious flavors of black cherry, blackberry jam, black raspberry and currants with vanilla tones
- 78 Cline, "Ancient Vines", California **\$88**
Spicy, bright strawberry, coffee and chocolate characters. Ripe fruit and soft tannins make this a mouth-coating rich vintage. Aging on new and used oak gives a subtle vanilla quality that nicely complements the explosive fruit notes.

Aromas of black cherries, red ripe plums, spices, and hints of vanilla. The palate mimics those fruits with a touch of leather accents and velvety tannins, while a rich and luscious mouthfeel tie the whole package together.
- 88 Duckhorn Vineyards, Napa Valley, California **\$235**
A luxurious red fruit flavours of strawberry, plum, cherry & loganberry. A lingering finish with hints of maple, cedar and sweet spice.
- 101 Round Hill, Rutherford Vineyards, California **\$70**
A ruby colored wine, bright and flavorful with ripe berry, fruit and spice notes. Aromas and flavors of ripe strawberry, cranberry, vanilla and dark chocolate. Soft, elegant mouthfeel with refined, silky tannins and smooth finish
- 87 Stags Leap, Stags' Leap Winery, Napa Valley, California **\$215**
The palate is generous and dense with mouth pleasing fruit flavours, polished structure, refreshing acidity and plush tannins.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

- 76 Round Hill, Rutherford Vineyards, California **\$70**
Deep ruby color with fruit and spice characteristics. Aromas of blackberry, black cherry and caramel. Juicy flavors of plum, blackberry, and caramel. Good acidity, soft tannins and a long smooth finish
- 75 Bonterra, North Coast, California (made with organic grapes) **\$110**
Petite Sirah, Merlot and Syrah add a touch of color, texture and spice to this Cabernet Sauvignon-focused blend. A brilliant dark ruby hue hints at the wine's powerful aromas and flavors of blueberry, blackcurrant and plum, layered over rich notes of leather, tobacco and graphite.
- 67 Bain's Way, Wellington, South Africa **\$68**
Aromas of nuts and pure cassis lead to a textured palate and lingering berry fruit flavors
- 57 Fortress, Sonoma County, California **\$140**
Layered palate of dark fruits with soft tannins, notes of cocoa and white pepper
- 48 Duckhorn Vineyards, Napa Valley, California **\$375**
It is juicy and bright, with luxurious cassis and dark berry flavors. Supported by notes of fig, Cardamom, clove and cracked black pepper that linger on, well-structured finished.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

- 81 Grgich Hills Estate, Estate Grown, Napa Valley, California **\$298**
Rich flavors of black currants, fruit, clove and mocha, topped off by liquorice with a long finish
- 64 Silver Oak Cellars "Alexander Valley", Napa, CA **\$395**
Garnet color with a ruby red rim and bluish tint. Alluring nose of chocolate-covered strawberries, vanilla, nutmeg, truffle and sage. On the palate, it has a broad yet delicate entry and offers cranberry flavors.
- 50 Hahn Estate, Monterey County, California **\$100**
Inviting blackberry, blueberry and tobacco aromas are complemented by notes of vanilla and toasted oak. Rich and robust tannins frame flavors of blackberry cream, violet and mature red fruit, leading to smooth, opulent finish, flavors on the wine.
- 111 Caymus Vineyards Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, California **\$430**
Very lush in feel, with flavours of ripe blackberry, black cherry and currants with complex Spice showing notes of cacao, cinnamon and rush vanilla oak.
- 92 Paul Hobbs, Napa Valley, California **\$495**
Luxuriant aromas of red currant, boysenberry, cedar box, and Herbes de Provence. The intensely layered palate excites with flavors of cassis, graphite, blueberries, and sage, woven seamlessly together with savory, velvety tannins.
- 44 Far Niente Nickel & Nickel, C.C. Ranch, Napa Valley, Rutherford, California **\$350**
Deeply expressive Cabernet with heady black currant, plum, and cedar aromas leading into a big, juicy entry. Layered currant and black cherry flavors are accented by elegant clove notes. Bold, coating tannins frame the entire wine, and hints of wet slate add dimension to a dark, brooding finish.
- 51 Wente Vineyards, Estate Grown, Livermore Valley, California **\$135**
Notes of earth and cocoa dust are complemented by spice and dark fruits, such as blackberry.
- 84 ZD Wines, Napa Valley, California **\$265**
The aroma explodes with ripe cassis, blackberry, plum, and a hint of cedar. The intense dark fruit is complemented by subtle hints of clove, toast, and soft vanilla. The palate is full and round with silky tannins that envelope the intense core of fruit that carries through to an incredibly long finish.
- 66 Michael David, Freakshow, American Canyon, California **\$120**
Bold and full bodied showcasing flavors of red cherry, hints of floral and dark fruit with tannins coming through the lasting, oak-kissed finish.
- 106 Stags Leap, Stags' Leap Winery, Napa Valley, California **\$315**
The dark berry fruits proliferate with blackberry, plum & cassis with savory elements showcasing light herbal notes and earth.

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OTHER REDS

- 93 M. Chapoutier, Belleruche Côtes du Rhône, Rhône Valley, France **\$99**
Deep garnet red in color. Intense, fruitiness of blackcurrant and raspberry on the nose; complimented by notes of white pepper. Juicy and fruity on the palate with roasted notes. There are silky and delicate tannins
- 107 Caymus Conundrum, Red Blend, California **\$130**
Rich, complex and approachable wine with lush flavours of cherries & baking chocolate. This wine has fine tannins and a silky smoothness.
- 96 The Chocolate Block, Red Blend, Franschhoek, South Africa **\$150**
Flavors of dark plums and notes of dust, graphite and cocoa nib. This wine focused and elegant, with fresh yet integrated acidity and fine-grained tannins, adding to exceptional structure. Blackcurrant and milk chocolate linger on a silky finish.
- 99 Farnese Fantini, Sangiovese, Abruzzo, Italy **\$65**
Vibrant red fruit, crushed Morello cherries with herbal undertones; raspberry, vanilla oak with spice, lively acidity and firm tannins
- 95 Marqués de Murrieta, Rioja Reserva, Logroño, Spain **\$140**
Aromas of ripe fruit and berries, plums, prunes, with spicy notes, dark chocolate and vanilla
- 82 Bolla Amarone della Valpolicella Classico DOC, Italy **\$198**
Deep garnet, velvety red in color. Aromas of wild-cherry jam, spice, and hints of cedar. On the palate, the wine is rich and dry, with black-cherry flavors. Round and long on the finish with cacao and spice notes

Medium-bodied on the palate, the wine shows lovely balance with hints of roasted coffee beans, ripe fruit, silky tannins, and a lingering finish.
