



BY THE SEA

BRIGHTON WATERSPORTS

Distance from The Grand: 4 minutes walking
Head out on kayaks or paddleboards and explore Brighton by sea, starting from the base of Brighton Watersports between the Palace Pier and the iconic West Pier.


PIER PRESSURE
