Lord Hall has had a long and distinguished career, working at the BBC from 1973 until 2001 when he left his role as Director of News and Current Affairs to become Chief Executive of the Royal Opera House. He was asked to return to the BBC as Director General in 2013 to lead the organisation in the wake of the shocking revelations around Jimmy Saville, where he oversaw the implementation of the recommendations from Dame Janet Smith's investigation and report.

He was also Chair of the Cultural Olympics, sitting on the Board of LOCOG and was Deputy Chair of Channel 4.

Lord Hall is an experienced trustee and chair of a number of boards, and is a crossbench life peer in the House of Lords.

BEHIND ENEMY LINES – CAN DEMOCRACY SURVIVE A DIGITAL REVOLUTION?

Mark is a strategic communications expert with extensive experience in corporate and political communications and conflict transformation. He is the former MD of the international political campaigning arm of Cambridge Analytica, using data-driven communications to run election campaigns and advise political and government clients in some of the most challenging countries in the world.

Mark spent a decade in theatres of conflict, under contract to the British and American governments and the UN, planning and directing ‘social change’ communications campaigns. Mark’s experience also includes a three-year counter-propaganda campaign against the Kremlin on behalf of exiled oligarch, Boris Berezovsky, and former KGB officer Alexander Litvinenko – a foreshadowing of the Russian nerve agent attack against the Skripals in Salisbury in 2018.

Mark will be sharing stories from his past campaigns and the challenges facing governments in today’s unstable environment.

Matt is the Brand Ambassador for Nc'nean, a small independent distillery on the west coast of Scotland.

Nc'nean is an independent, organic whisky distillery creating experimental spirits and pioneering sustainable production.

Located in Drimnin in the Highlands of Scotland, the distillery focuses on producing an organic spirit with minimum impact on the local environment. The distillery was the first in the UK to reach net zero carbon emissions during whisky production and uses renewable electricity, offsets emissions by forest planting and uses 100% recycled glass in its bottles.

Matt will be sharing the history of the brand and guests will have the opportunity to sample some Nc'nean inspired cocktails.
